



# Driver Safety for Businesses

According to research by the Department for Transport, driving is likely to be one of the most dangerous activities we engage in, with far more people being killed or injured driving whilst at work, than in any of the high-risk industries

## Course Overview

Any business that has staff who drive as part of their work, whether regularly or occasionally, in either a company provided vehicle, or an employee's own vehicle, has a legal duty under Health and Safety at Work legislation to manage driving risk properly.

Failure to manage your work-related driving activities can result in:

- Unnecessary risk to staff and other road users
- Huge fines for any failings in Duty of Care (fines linked to turnover)
- Putting you, your organisation and your reputation at risk

This half day course will ensure you gain a full understanding of the processes your business should have in place to manage work related road safety and is a necessity for the key decision makers to ensure that the business is compliant with Health and Safety Legislation.
