



Telescopic Handler All Sizes

Does your forklift not access certain locations? A telescopic handler is convenient when moving large amounts to and from different places & a formal qualification is vital to keep you and your colleagues safe.

Course Overview

This course is for all Plant Operators who use telescopic handlers and is suitable for novices, intermediate level or experienced operators who need to refresh their skills or achieve the relevant CPCS card.

The objective of the course is to provide training for individuals who wish to operate a telescopic handler at a competent level. This can be delivered either as an in-house course or CPCS course.

Course Syllabus

The course content includes all aspects of theoretical and practical skills in the operation of a telescopic handler including:

- Identify the basic construction, purpose and function of components, and the purpose and use of controls and gauges
- Identify and comply with manufacturers' instructions in accordance with the operator's handbook, other sources of information and applicable legislation
- Carry out pre-checks
- Configure the telescopic handler for site and road travel
- Travel over differing types of terrain, including rough undulating ground and substantial inclines, both with and without loads
- Manoeuvre in confined areas using forward and reverse direction, both with and without loads
- Set the telescopic handler in order to lift loads
- Lift various loads within the full working range of the telescopic handler
- Ensure load integrity and security
- Transport loads
- Place and retrieve loads accurately at various points
- Place and retrieve loads from vehicle bed or trailer
- Explain precautions to be taken for overhead services and other hazards
- Keep within safe working parameters
- Place the machine in an out-of-service condition
- Explain the loading and unloading procedure on and off a transporter
