



P405 Management of Asbestos in Buildings



Under Regulation 4 of the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012, all non-domestic premises must have a Duty Holder who has ultimate responsibility to manage the asbestos in the premises.

Course Overview

This course provides delegates with practical knowledge and skills to manage asbestos in buildings and to provide a basic knowledge of asbestos removal procedures.

The course is designed for individuals who have the responsibility of managing asbestos in buildings, the duty holder. This training is in accordance with all current HSE guidelines and the BOHS syllabus.

Course Syllabus

- Understanding of the legislation relating to asbestos and those aspects of other health and safety regulations relevant to the management of asbestos in buildings
- Identify the main types of asbestos materials in buildings
- Understand the appropriate means of recording their locations and be fully aware of the procedures and methods for the prevention of future damage to asbestos containing materials
- Development of an action plan on the basis of survey information
- Knowledge of how to manage the asbestos that remains in the premises by suitable schemes
- Good practice for asbestos remediation, including encapsulation, sealing and removal operations
- Identify examples of poor working procedures in practical situations
- Understand the role of the analyst, air monitoring techniques and the four-stage clearance procedure
- Convert survey data into a building management action plan
- Carry out thorough appraisal of contractor documentation and methods
- Appreciation of the pressures and demands on various parties during an asbestos removal project
