



Fire Safety Awareness in Care Homes

Persons over the age of 80 are ten times more likely to die in a fire than someone aged 30 or under. The current Fire Safety Order states that fire risks must be managed in places of work.

Course Overview

Impaired mobility means that increased fire safety awareness is essential in all care homes.

This course is suitable for those who work in care homes not having designated fire duties but who require a basic level of fire safety awareness.

It will cover why fires occur and what actions must be taken to help prevent them starting and the actions to be taken when they do.
