

Rooftop Safety

Roof work is dangerous. According to the HSE, roofers account for 24% – the biggest category of workers by far – of those people who are killed in all falls from height

Course Overview

Trainees will be given detailed information and knowledge about rooftop safety, enabling them to identify potential hazards, with discussion about permanent and temporary methods of fall protection (fall arrest and fall restraint). They will be instructed how to carry out pre-use checks on personal protective equipment and then put it on correctly. Trainees will also practise how to use some fall protection systems commonly found on rooftops; they will be shown climbing techniques and the safe use of portable and fixed ladders. This training does not cover pitched roofs.

The course is aimed at operatives, managers and supervisors who work, or manage working, on rooftops.
