Course Overview

Working Safely is a one day course for staff from any sector with no supervisory or managerial responsibility. The course provides a grounding in the essentials of health and safety so that delegates gain an understanding of why they must work safely.

The course focuses on why health and safety is important and how people can make a difference to their own well being by changing their behaviour.

Course Syllabus

The course focuses on why health and safety is important, and how delegates can make a real difference to the safety culture of the organisation.

- Identifying hazards and evaluating risks within the workplace
- The use of appropriate work place precautions for specifics or seek advice on workplace precautions
- Assist managers in preparing risk assessments
- Co-operate and communicate on safety matters
- Improving health and safety matters
- Improving health and safety performance
- Carry out work activities without risk to themselves or others
- Reporting of relevant accidents and incidents
- Monitor their own activities and assist managers in active monitoring
- Protecting the environment
