#### **Course Overview**

The CITB Site Supervisors' Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS) course is for those who have, or are about to acquire, supervisory responsibilities on a construction site.

Being a supervisor on a construction site is an extremely important responsibility, so it is vital that those in such a position have the necessary knowledge to ensure that others are working safely on site. The SSSTS qualification will give site supervisors a level of understanding of certain issues such as their legal health and safety responsibilities.

#### **Course Syllabus**

At the end of the course delegates should be able to understand the health, safety, welfare and environmental health and safety issues relevant to their work activities and also understand their legal health and safety responsibilities relevant to their work activities and therefore safely supervise activities on a construction site

Key topics of the SSSTS course include:

- The Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 and relevant health and safety regulations
- Identification of specific construction site health and safety issues including substances hazardous to health (COSHH), Working at Height etc.
- Tool Box talks
- Control of subcontractors
- Health related issues
- Risk assessments and site inductions
- Proactive and reactive monitoring
- Working at height
- Demolition
- Noise
- Occupational health
- Confined spaces
- Fire
- Electricity
