

In 2014, an estimated 909,000 working hours were lost and nearly a quarter of all RIDDOR reported injuries were attributed to poor manual handling practices.

Course Overview

The Manual Handling Regulations 1992, as amended in 2002 apply to a wide range of manual handling activities, including lifting, lowering, pushing, pulling or carrying. It is a requirement of these regulations to carry out risk assessments on manual handling tasks. Manual Handling Training can form part of your safe systems of work.

Our manual handling course is suitable for operators, managers, supervisors and employees to protect themselves from risk of injury through manual handling tasks encountered in the workplace.
