Course Overview

This course will provide delegates with an understanding of health and safety that will enable them to work safely without risk of injury to themselves or others, including all employers, supervisors and employees in any work environment

Course Syllabus

The aims and objectives of the course is to allow the learner to understand:

- Understand the principles of health and safety and accident prevention
- Health & Safety requirements placed on employers and employees. Hazard and risk and the main causes of harm to workers.
- Health, safety and welfare of provisions in the workplace.
- The importance of following safe systems of work, procedures and rules.
- Hazards and controls in respect to both safety and occupational health risks.
- Understand how their own actions can reduce risks to health and safety.
- Appreciate how workplace equipment and task design affect health and safety

- Workplace and work equipment
- Risk assessment , manual handling and hazardous substances
